

## Hanging Sign Request Form Due April 8

All exhibitors wishing to display a hanging sign in their booth must complete this form and return it to IDDBA no later than **April 8, 2022** to <u>al@iddba.org</u>. Hanging signs will be considered for any size island booth only. This form must be filled out in addition to the <u>Island Booth Configuration Form</u>. The sign must fall within the guidelines specified below. IDDBA, GES, and/or the Georgia World Congress Center reserves the right to reject any hanging sign, at any time. State/Country Section Coordinators - please call the Exhibits Team for section hanging sign guidelines.

## Sign Guidelines:

- Island booths 20'x20' (A4) through 50'x70' (A35) can apply.
- The top of the sign can be hung at 18' maximum.
- No truss, support, or hanging signs can exceed the outline of the purchased space.
- The sign can span the entire cubic content of the booth up to the maximum height of 18' (from the floor).
- Rigging installation may not exceed the limit of 200 lbs. per hanging point.
- Take care to use only rated rigging hardware when designing and constructing the sign. All hardware is required to have a working load limit (W.L.L.).
- All points where nylon slings are used will require a steel safety cable.
- Rigging in some areas of the center requires special arrangements.

Sign Limits (subject to IDDBA approval):

20'x20' - 20'x50' booths: 2 signs 20'x60' - 50'x70' booths: 3 signs

- Requests must be submitted to IDDBA no later than April 8, 2022. It must include:
  - pictures or drawings
  - original to scale blueprint with original engineer signature and original engineer stamp/signature
  - height, width, length dimensions, weight, hanging points, and locations of hanging points
  - positioning with regards to the booth (floorprint)
  - materials used in construction
- Any sign, or portion thereof, deemed unsafe for overhead suspension will not be allowed.

Date:

Any violation in sign regulations will result in removal of sign at the exhibitor's expense and/or closure of booth.

Rigging Orders: Must be submitted to GES by May 6, 2022. The Rigging Order form will be provided to you once the hanging sign is accepted by IDDBA.

Sign Shipping: All hanging signs must be shipped in advance and received at the GES Warehouse no later than May 27, 2022.
